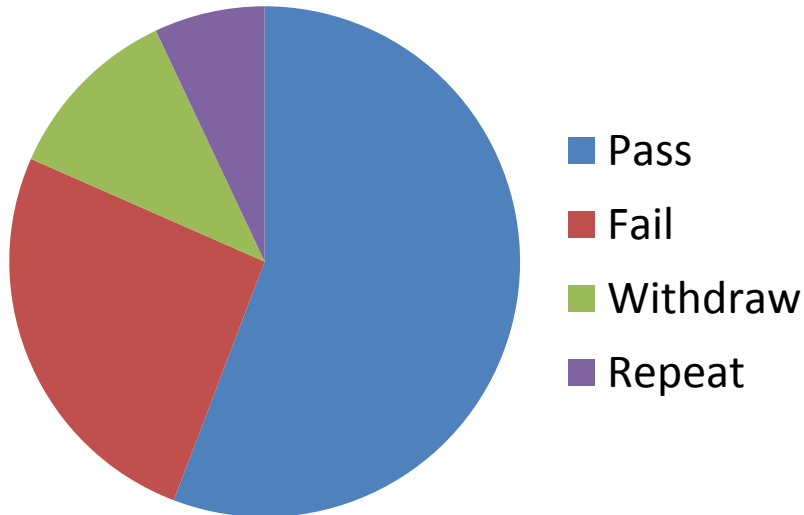

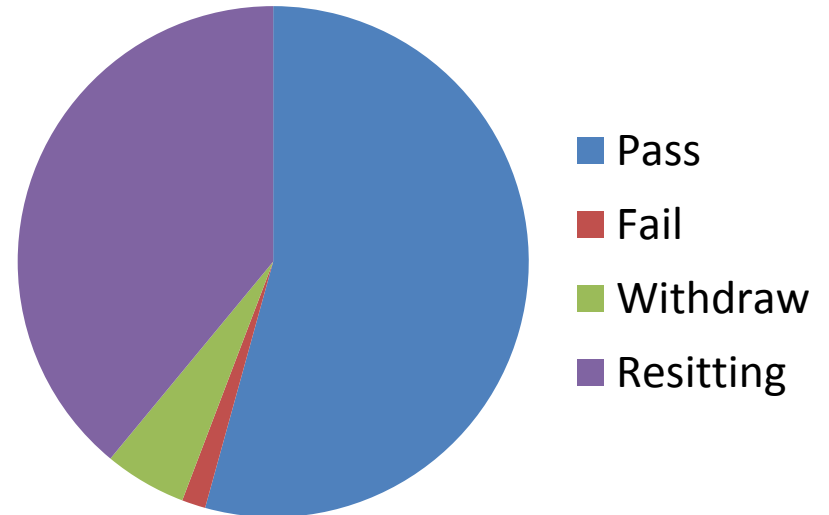
**2009/10**

**Number of Students (1072)**



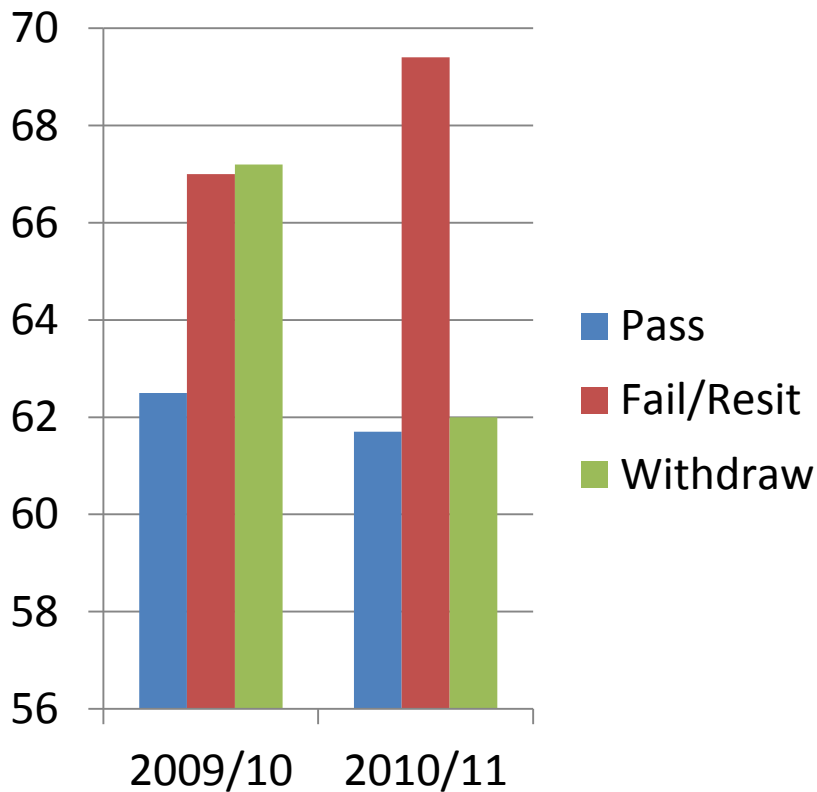
**2010/2011**

# How are Withdraw/Fail students different?

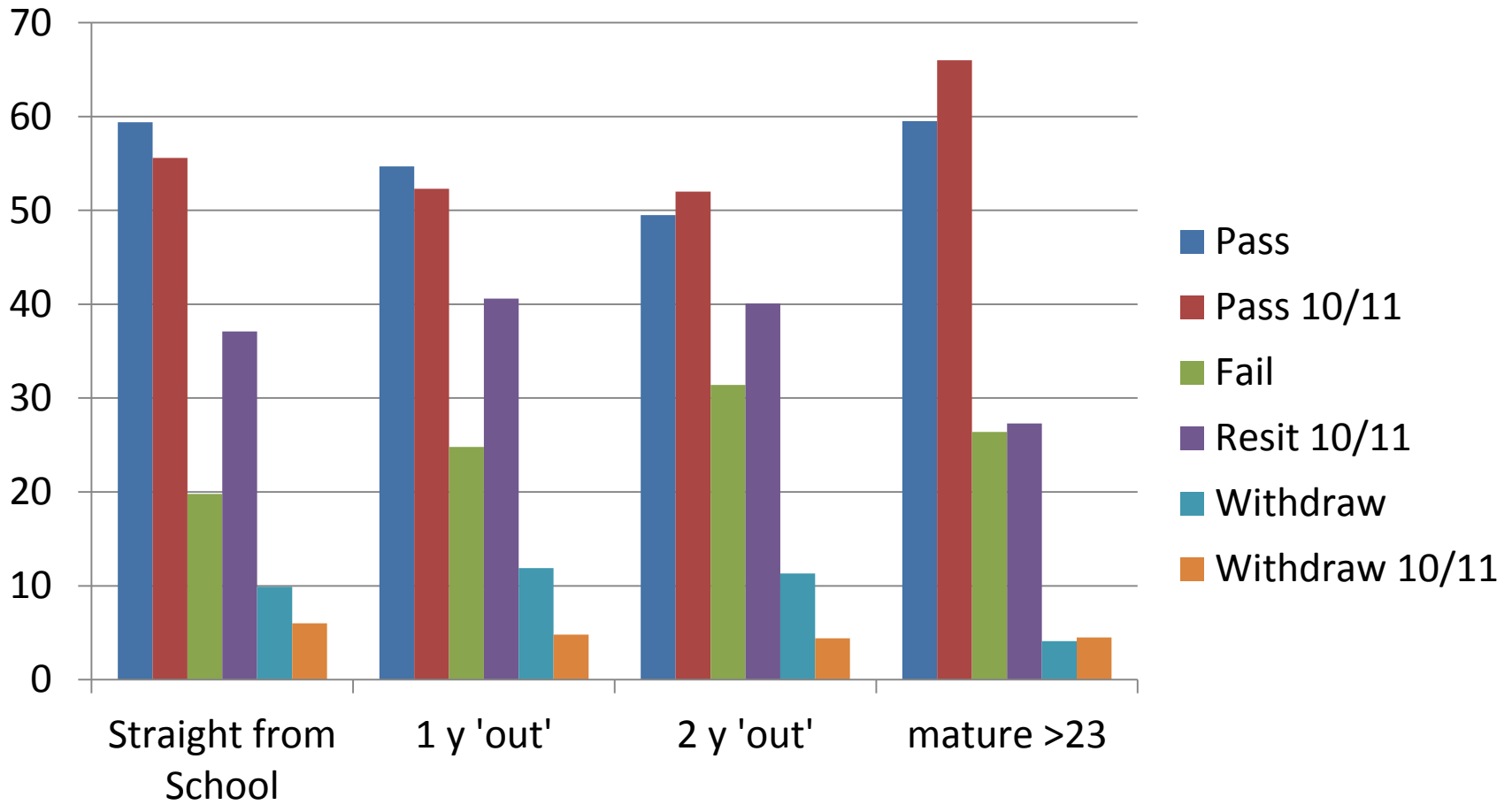
## Gender: % Males



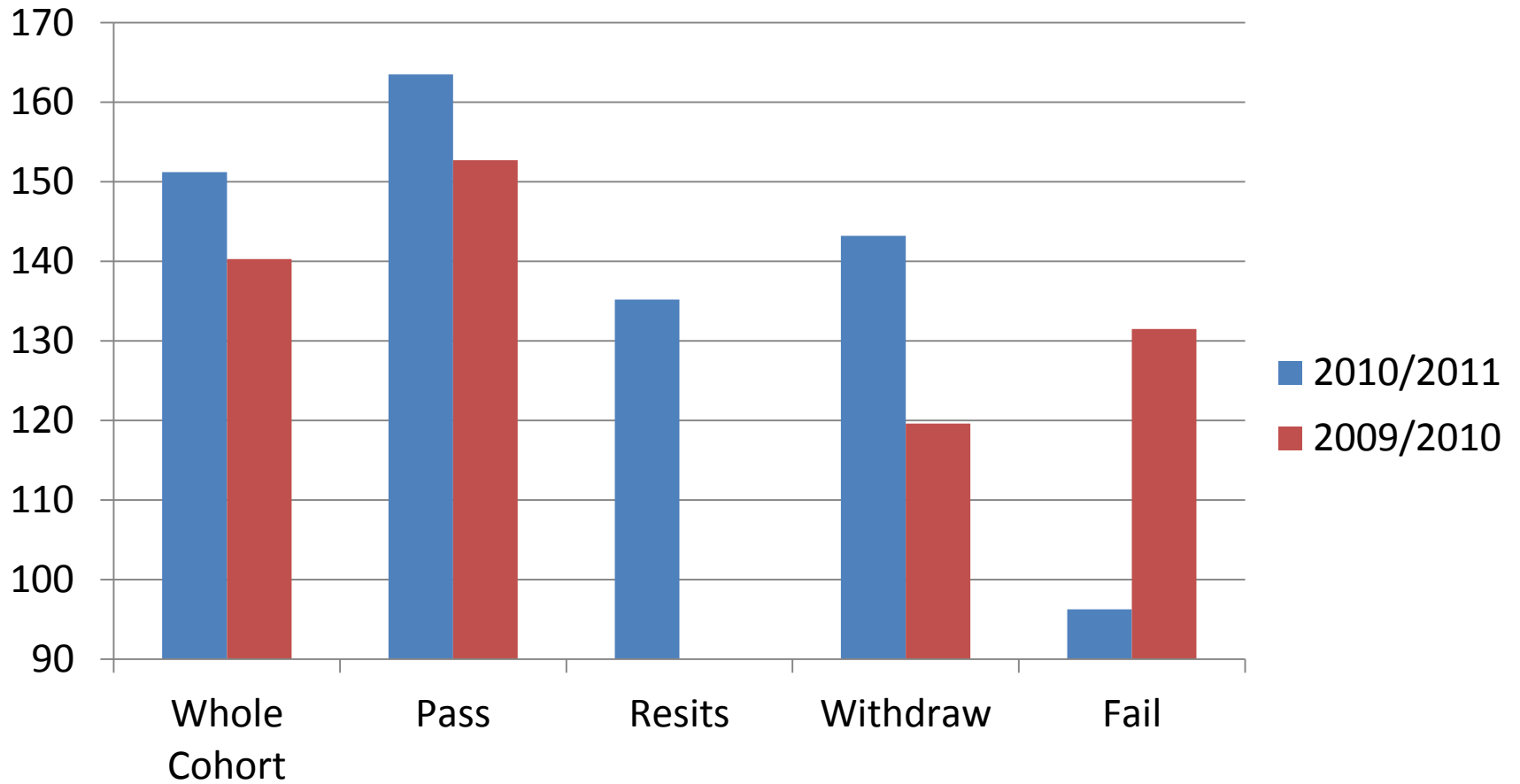
## Student Support?

- 34% Pass students
- 28% Fail students

- 52.1 % (559) No Tariff Points

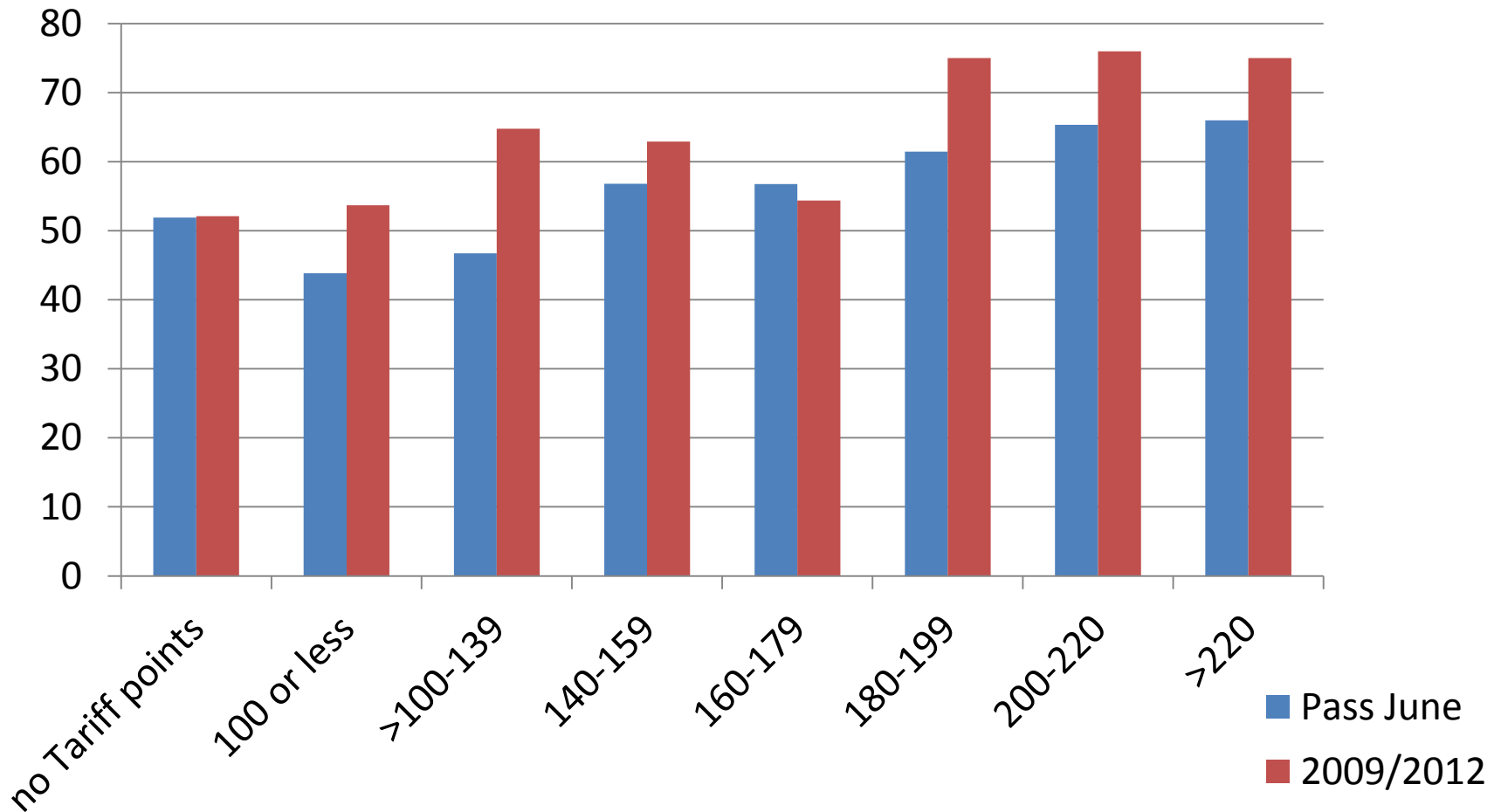
## 2010/2011

These students:

- More likely to be from Manchester,
- less likely to be in Hall,
- Have a higher mean Age
- Less likely to withdraw

# Summary

## **Withdraw Students are less likely to be:**

- in Halls
- live locally
- be over 23 or come straight from school

## **Are more likely to**

- have enrolled in a previous academic year
- have taken 1-2 years 'out'

## **Fail Students are**

- More likely to have lower Tariff point score
